



for and the matter was placed in Chamber. On 31.1.2013, counsel for the petitioner sought further time to bring on record the legal representatives of deceased respondent No.2. In the interest of justice, further four weeks' time was allowed. Again on 15.7.2013, the matter was listed before this court in Chamber and two weeks more time was granted to file a proper application. Finally on 10.9.2013, the matter was again placed before the Chamber Judge. Three weeks further time was allowed. In spite of such indulgences and adjournments, the order and direction has not been complied with. Hence this special leave petition stands abated as against Respondent No.2.
