Heard Mr. Gopal Subramaniam, learned senior counsel for the petitioner.

Delay condoned.

Special Leave Petitions are dismissed. However, in the interest of justice time granted by the High Court to the petitioner to deposit Rs. 21 crores in the trial court is extended by a further period of two weeks from today.

In case, the above amount is not deposited within two weeks, the order of temporary injunction shall not come in to operation. Upon deposit of Rs. 21 crores, the trial court shall pass appropriate orders for investment of the same in a fixed deposit in a nationalised bank.

Having regard to the facts of the case, we expect the trial court to decide the suit expeditiously and preferably by the end of 2013.
