



Broadly, the settlement is that both will divide the lands which are the subject matter of the agreement (that is 10 acres 13 cents of wet and one acre and 30 cents of dry land) situated in the villages of Venugopalapuram and Vizianagaram equally. Similarly, Whatever amount that has been deposited by the defendant-purchaser in court, will also be divided between them equally. However, as the lands to be divided are situated in two villages under different survey numbers and some of them are wet lands and some of them are dry lands, parties are working out the details of actual division. They, therefore seek four weeks' time to file a Compromise Petition signed by both parties showing the decision division (if necessary, with a sketch showing details of the lands that are to be taken by each party). A memo has been filed signed by learned counsel for both parties to that effect. The said memo is taken on record and the matter is adjourned by four weeks for
