UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. At the time of hearing, it was pointed out by the learned counsel for the petitioner that there is another Transfer Petition (Civil)No.448/2026 filed by the husband against the respondent-wife.
2. Let the aforesaid petition and the other connected matters be listed together on the next date of hearing.
3. On the joint request of the parties, we refer the dispute to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.
4. The parties shall virtually appear before the Coordinator

of the Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 16<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 at 2.30 p.m.

5. In the event the learned Mediator desires personal presence of the parties, the parties shall appear physically.

6. The learned Mediator, after making an endeavour for amicable resolution of the dispute, shall submit a report to this Court within a period of two months from the date of the first appearance of the parties.

7. The Registry shall ensure that a copy of this order along with relevant documents is forwarded to the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center at the earliest.

8. Adjourned to 18<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

9. In the meantime, further proceedings in Maintenance Petition bearing Mt.Case No.872/2018 titled as "*Neetu @ Annapurna vs. Manish Kumar @ Munna*" pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, District East, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, shall remain stayed.
