UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) vehemently argues that the impugned judgment approves a qualification which is not mentioned as an essential qualification in the advertisement.
3. Considering that the High Court has referred to two similar orders passed in O.A. 878 of 2024 *Shubhani Singh*

vs. Union Territory of Chandigarh & Ors. and in O.A. No. 1031 of 2024 *Lalita Kaushik vs. Union Territory, Chandigarh*, and also that the subject qualification which has been approved by the Single Judge is not contrary to the NCTE norms, we are not inclined to interfere with the matter.

4. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed, however, question of law is kept open.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
