O R D E R

After arguments for some time Mr. PP Rao, learned senior counsel for the petitioner urged that in arriving at the decision as to the quantum of excess payment some factual and mathematical errors, obvious and patent on record, according to the learned counsel have crept in and that the petitioner may be permitted to approach the High Court itself to get the same rectified or clarified.
