order dated 29.1.2007 passed by the High Court of Allahabad in Contempt Petition No.1733 of 2006.

Special Leave Petition (C)No...../2007 (CC No.1571) is directed against the judgment and order dated 02.03.2006 passed by a learned Single Judge of the High Court of Allahabad in Civil Misc. Writ Petition No.45006/2001.

According to the petitioners, the writ appeal against the order of the learned Single Judge, which is pending before the High Court for a long time, has not even been taken up for admission and consideration of interim relief. On the other hand, the learned Single

Judge is proceeding with the contempt proceedings filed before him.

We see merit in the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners. We, therefore, request the High Court to take up the writ appeal for admission and consideration of interim relief as expeditiously as possible.

Till the disposal of the application for interim relief, the contempt proceedings pending before the learned Single Judge shall remain stayed.

We make it clear that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.

The Special Leave Petitions are disposed of accordingly.
