The petitioner/applicant Thapar Institute of Engineering and Technology, which is an unaided university, seeks to give reservation of 1% of the total seats for wards of the employees of the University. A clarification to this extent is sought for of the Order of this Court dated 11.12.1996. This Court passed an order for admission and allocation of seats but reservation was not permitted in the Order. We make it clear that despite the Order passed by this Court dated 11.12.1996, the applicant-University would be at liberty to have admission of 1% seats for the wards of the employees.
