UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the order dated 27.11.2025 in Bail Application No.2018 of 2025, titled "*Tushar Saexna Vs. The State of GNCT of Delhi*", passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.

With the framing of charge, if any, and the examination of material prosecution witnesses, it shall be open to the petitioner to revive his prayer for grant of bail which shall be considered on its own merits.
