O R D E R

The learned counsel for the respondents (alleged contemnors) states that so far as the arrears w.e.f. 1.1.1996 or the date of appointment, whichever is later, are concerned, sanction has been granted and disbursement shall be made within one week.

So far as the petitioners' claim for "not only basic pay but allowances and HRA also" is concerned, we do not think that any case of contempt is made out in that regard in view of the order dated November 7, 2003 in C.A. No. 8745 of 2003. The order does not specifically grant such relief to the petitioners. The petitioners are at liberty to seek clarification in the order of this Court.

So far as the contempt proceedings are concerned, the same are dropped and rule is discharged. Contempt Petition stands disposed of.
