O R D E R

In this petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution, the petitioner has made the following substantive prayers:

"a) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to include Sawar, Sawara, Saunra, Sanwra, Saura & Sahra in the list of Schedule Tribe of the State of Chhattisgarh at Serial No.41 within certain fixed time limit at the earliest.

(b) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for inclusion of Sawar, Sawara, Saunra, Sanwra, Saura & Sahra in the list of Schedule Tribe of the State of Chhattisgarh at Serial No.41; or

(c) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the like nature thereby commanding the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in accordance with law."

After arguing the case for some time, learned senior counsel for the petitioner made a request that his client may be permitted to withdraw the petition.

The request of the learned senior counsel is accepted and the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy by filing a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution before the jurisdictional High Court.
