ORDER

As the petitioners were not able to prove the actual income of the deceased, even no documentary evidence was adduced to show that what could be his earnings, we are of the opinion that applying the formula as laid down in the Second Schedule of the Motors Vehicle Act, the petitioners could have obtained compensation for a sum of Rs.2,70,000/- only. As the High Court has passed an award of Rs.3,68,600/-, we are not inclined to interfere. The special leave petition is dismissed.
