These petitions are directed against order dated 17.11.2010 by which the learned Single Judge dismissed the application filed by the petitioners under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 for condonation of 1628 days' delay in filing an appeal under Section 54 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 and consequently dismissed the appeal.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and carefully perused the record. In our view, the cause shown by the petitioners for delayed filing of the appeal before the High Court was wholly unsatisfactory and the learned Single Judge rightly declined to

entertain their prayer for condonation of almost 5 years' delay.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.
