O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner-convict and having gone through the materials available on record, we find no good ground to interfere with the impugned judgment and order passed by the High Court.

However, taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has already undergone more than 14 years of sentence by now, he may prefer an appropriate representation addressed to the competent authority of the State, praying for remission of the sentence, in accordance with the remission policy of the State Government.

4. If any such representation is preferred, the competent authority shall look into the same at the earliest and inform about the outcome of the same to the petitioner in writing.

5. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
