O R D E R

- Respondent Nos. 1 and 2 appear on caveat.
- 2. We are informed that respondent Nos. 3-6 are not necessary parties for consideration of the present matter.
- 3. Leave granted.
- 4. Having regard to the controversy involved in the matter, we are satisfied that the Single Judge of the High Court was not justified in directing the appellant-University to renew the affiliation by way of an interim order. The Division Bench erred in upholding the erroneous order of the Single Judge.
- 5. The orders dated October 12, 2012 passed by the Single Judge in Writ Petition No. 21752 (W) of 2012 - The Governing Body of Eastern Dooars B.Ed. Training College and others vs. The University of North Bengal and others and dated January 30, 2013 affirmed by the Division Bench in M.A.T. No. 1909 of 2012 in C.A.N. No. 11659 of 2012 are set-aside.
- 6. We request the Single Judge to hear and dispose of the Writ Petition No. 21752 (W) of 2012 as expeditiously as may be possible and preferably within two months from today. We record the statement of Mr. K.V. Vishwanathan, learned senior counsel for the appellants that the appellants shall fully cooperate in expeditious disposal of the above Writ Petition. Counter-affidavit in reply to the Writ Petition No. 21752 (W) of 2012 shall be filed by the appellants, if not filed so far, within two weeks from today.
- 7. Needless to say that the Single Judge shall consider the Writ Petition on its own merits. As it is this order has no bearing for final consideration of the Writ Petition.
- 8. Appeals stand disposed of. No costs.
