Delay condoned.

This petition is directed against order dated 05.10.2012 whereby the writ petition filed by the petitioners was dismissed and the order passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal directing the competent authority to decide the representation of respondent No.1 and to consider his case for promotion was upheld. We have heard learned Additional Solicitor General appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Shri S.L. Gupta, caveator-in-person and perused the record.

In our view, the impugned order does not suffer from any legal infirmity warranting interference under Article 136 of the Constitution. We may add that in similar matters, this Court had already dismissed the special leave petitions. Reference in this connection may be made to order dated 14.1.2013 passed in SLP (C) No.1857 of 2013 - Union of India and another vs. R.N. Kurmi and others.

The special leave petition is accordingly dismissed.
