UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard Shri Ranjit Kumar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, as well as the learned senior counsel/counsel for the respondents, who appears on caveat.
2. Since the prayer concerns modifying paragraphs 56 and 57 of the High Court's judgment dated 25.10.2025, and asks for CMRL to be directed to pay the recovered amount, we are of the view that the appropriate course for the petitioner is to approach the High Court for clarification or to request a modification of the order.
3. It is clarified that we have not expressed any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's claim. The parties shall be free to present their contentions before the High Court. We also request the High Court to oversee the ongoing investigation as per paragraph 54 of the judgment and ensure that appropriate lawful coercive action is taken against those found involved in the systematic fraud.
4. The Special Leave Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
5. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
