Accordingly, we have heard learned counsel for parties. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and keeping in view the comparative convenience of both the parties, we feel that the petition deserves to be allowed. Accordingly, while allowing the petition, we direct that the aforementioned suit shall stand transferred from Family Court Mumbai to the Court of District Judge,
