Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the parties have

amicably settled all outstanding disputes pursuant to which an application for withdrawal of Criminal Case No. 86 of 2012 (Old No. 700 of 2009) titled Prem Kumar Kapoor Vs. Deepak Kumar Agnihotri pending before Learned Judicial Magistrate-2, District Court, Aligarh, U.P. has also been filed,.
