Delay condoned.

We are informed that the respondent, Rashpal Singh, was involved in another offence of a similar nature after grant of bail by way of the impugned order, wherein the quantity of contraband seized was a commercial quantity, and he is presently in custody in relation therewith. We, therefore, find no grounds to interfere

with the impugned order passed by the High Court, granting him bail in the earlier offence, which did not involve a commercial quantity.

We, however, make it clear that the impugned order cannot be treated as a precedent or for drawing parity, as each case would turn upon the individual facts therein.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
