O R D E R

1. The petitioners challenge the judgment and order dated 12.12.2025 in CRP No.4867/2025 titled "*Kumaravel & Anr. vs. N. Palanisamy & Ors.*" passed by the High Court of Judicature at Madras.

2. According to the petitioners, the property worth Rs.1.5 Crores has been sold for a paltry sum of Rs.27,10,000/-. To establish their *bona fides* let the petitioners deposit a sum of Rs.1.5 Crores in the Registry of this Court on or before 26.02.2026.
