O R D E R

1. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the deceased did not receive any injury over his head or any other sensitive or vital part of his body and the death occurred due to complications from the injury. However, the Trial Court while convicting the petitioner for offence

punishable under Section 304 Part I of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, has sentenced the petitioner to undergo life imprisonment. It is also submitted that the appeal before the High Court is of the year 2024 and therefore, there is no possibility of the appeal being heard in the near future.

2. Issue notice, returnable in eight weeks.

3. Mr. Pashupati Nath Razdan, learned Advocate on Record, has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent-State on advance notice and waives service of formal notice on behalf of the respondent-State.
