ORDER

1. This Transfer Petition has been filed by the petitioner No.1-wife seeking transfer of MAT Case No. 32 of 2024, titled as "*Sri Birupakshya Patro Vs. Smt. Shilpa Patra & Anr.*" pending before the Court of Senior Civil Judge, ASKA, Ganjam, Odisha to the Family Court, Surat, Gujarat.

2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners. None has appeared on behalf of the respondent-husband, though, as per the office report dated 12.05.2026, respondent No. 1 was served on 28.03.2026.

3. We have gone through the transfer petition and other materials on record and we are satisfied that a case has been made out for transfer of the proceedings.

4. Accordingly, we direct that the entire case record of MAT Case No. 32 of 2024, titled as "*Sri Birupakshya Patro Vs. Smt. Shilpa Patra & Anr.*" shall be forthwith transferred from the Court of Senior

Civil Judge, ASKA, Ganjam, Odisha to the Family Court, Surat, Gujarat.

5. It would be open to the respondent-husband to move the Family Court, Surat, Gujarat to appear through virtual mode, if the occasion so arises.

6. The Transfer Petition is allowed in the above terms.
