O R D E R

It appears that the High Court has issued non bailable warrants of arrest against the accused, petitioners herein, since advocate for the accused did not appear for arguments, and the matter is getting delayed.

This Court, vide order dated 24.2.2006, directed listing of the matter on 10th March, 2006 and interim stay till then.

If the Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioners appears before the High Court within three weeks from today and make a statement to the effect that he is prepared to go on with the hearing of the appeal, the High Court may recall the non bailable warrants. For three weeks from today, non bailable warrants shall not be executed.
