UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard Dr. Abhishek Manu Singhvi, learned Senior Counsel and Mr. Jayant Mehta, learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Shyam Divan, learned Senior Counsel, Mr. Vikas Mehta, learned counsel and Mr. Kazan Shroff, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos.1 and 2, the principal contesting parties.

2. Though, the impugned order is an order appointing an Arbitrator and arises out of the Section 11 petition, parties have suggested that without prejudice to their rights and contentions in the Special Leave Petition, they would like to explore an amicable resolution of the dispute through mediation.

3. In view of the same, we request Justice Shiavax Jal Vazifdar, former Chief Justice of the High Court of Punjab & Haryana to mediate the dispute between the parties. The parties shall get in touch with the learned Mediator and the schedule may be fixed depending as per the convenience of the learned Mediator. The fee payable to the learned Mediator shall be fixed after discussing the same with the learned Mediator.

4. List the matter after the receipt of the Mediation Report on 24.04.2026.

5. Considering that the matter is being referred to mediation, there shall be stay of proceedings before the learned Arbitrator.

6. The stay order is passed only for the purpose of Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the Court has not yet heard parties on the merits of the matter.
