This is a petition filed by the petitioner seeking for transfer of Divorce Case bearing Matrimonial Suit No. 4A of 2011 pending in the Court of Addl. District & Session Judge, Gadarwara, Madhya Pradesh to the Family Court at Pune, Maharashtra. During the pendency of the present petition in this Court, the parties were referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Center for settlement by appointing Ms. Asha G. Nair as the Mediator. Learned Mediator through her acumen helped and

assisted the parties to arrive at a settlement.
now settled their dispute on terms and conditions which
incorporated in a joint application filed by the parties before
this Court and also enclosed in the terms of settlement.

We have gone through the terms and conditions of
settlement and find them to be bonafide and valid. Considering
the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking notice of
the fact that the parties have arrived at a settlement out of
Court with the help and assistance of the learned Mediator, we
take the terms and conditions of settlement on record and make
the same an order of this Court. In terms thereof now, the
parties shall file a proper petition seeking for a decree of
divorce by mutual consent at Family Court, Pune, Maharashtra. As
and when such a petition is filed by the parties, the same shall
be considered by the concerned court and shall pass necessary
orders thereon without insisting on the waiting period as
provided in the Statute.

So far the remaining part of the settlement is concerned,
payment is required to be made of an amount of Rs. 7 lakhs by the
respondent as full and final amount of one time settlement to the
petitioner against all claims made by her. The draft of Rs. 7
lakhs is brought to the Court today and the same is handed over
to the counsel appearing for the petitioner in the Court which is
accepted in the Court itself. A photocopy of the same is also
kept on record.
