O R D E R

A perusal of the impugned judgment of the Tribunal reveals that while deciding the appeal in favour of the respondents herein, Tribunal had followed its earlier order. We find that against that order of the Tribunal appeal was preferred before this Court being C.A.No. 950/2004 and the issue on merit was decided against the assessee.

However, on the question of limitation this Court remanded the case back to the Tribunal for fresh adjudication. The judgment of this Court in case of Commnr. Of C.Ex., Chandigarh-II vs. Bhalla Enterprises is reported in 2004 (173) E.L.T. 225 (S.C.). Following that judgment we set aside the impugned order of the Tribunal as well and remit the case back to the Tribunal to decide the issue on limitation.

The appeals are disposed of in the above terms.
