**OFFICE REPORT**

The matters above mentioned were listed before the Hon'ble Court on 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2014, when the Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

Thereafter the matters above mentioned were listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2015, when the following order was passed:-

**"SLP(C) No. 18463/2014**  
**"Fresh steps for the service of notice by usual mode to the unserved respondents shall be taken by the learned counsel for the petitioners within a period of three weeks. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served through the Trial Court the particulars of which shall be furnished by the learned counsel for the petitioners within the period prescribed above.**

**List again on 21.7.2015."**

Thereafter the matters above mentioned were again listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court on 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2015, when the following order was passed:-

**"The office report is that service of notice is complete on the respondent Nos.1 & 3, but no one has entered appearance on their behalf.**

**The office report proceeds to state that although by order dated 21.07.2015 of this Court, four weeks time as last chance was given to the Ld.counsel for the petitioners to take fresh steps for the service of notice to the unserved respondent Nos.2 & 4, yet he has not been needful within the period stipulated in the order. Viewed in that context, the matter shall be processed for listing before the Hon'ble Judge in Chambers for further future directions. Await orders and list thereafter."**

It is submitted that there are four respondents and all are represented through Mr. T. R. B. Sivakumar, Advocate but he has not filed counter affidavit so far.

Service of show cause notice is complete.

The matters above mentioned are listed before the Ld. Registrar's Court with this office report.
