Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Delay condoned.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of
the present case, particularly, the statement in
Annexure P-3, that the matter has been settled by the
complainant, we reduce the sentence to the period
already undergone subject to condition that the
petitioners will deposit a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees

fifty thousand) each for payment to the complainant with the trial Court within a period of three months. If the payment is not made in terms this order, the sentence as awarded by the High Court will stand.

Since this order is being passed ex-parte, the respondent will be at liberty to move this Court, if aggrieved.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
