UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We do not see any ground to interfere with the impugned judgment and order dated 3.1.2012, passed by the High court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh in Criminal Appeal No.1050 of 2001 and it is liable to be dismissed.

Mr. R.K. Talwar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the complainant has filed an application with affidavit before this Court for compounding the offence and thus, the said application may be considered. Copy of the application as well as the affidavit has been perused. The petitioners stood acquitted for the offences under Section 307 IPC but has been convicted under Section 325 IPC and Section 324 read with Section 34 IPC. In view of the facts that Section 324 is not compoundable in view of the provision of Section 320 Cr.P.C., we are afraid that we cannot entertain such an application, particularly in view of the judgment of this Court in Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab & Anr. (2012) 10 SCC 303.

The petition stands dismissed.
