O R D E R

In SLP(C)No(s).5794/2011, the petitioner is aggrieved by refusal of the learned Single Judge of the Delhi High Court to condone 136 days' delay in filing of appeal under Section 54 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, 'the Act').

In SLP(C)No(s).5911/2011, the petitioner is aggrieved by refusal of the learned Single Judge of the Delhi High Court to condone 237 days' delay in filing of

appeal under Section 54 of the Act.

In SLP(C)No(s).5923/2011, the petitioner is aggrieved by refusal of the learned Single Judge of the Delhi High Court to condone 258 days' delay in filing of appeal under Section 54 of the Act.

In SLP(C)No(s).5925/2011, the petitioner is aggrieved by refusal of the learned Single Judge of the Delhi High Court to condone 108 days' delay in filing of appeal under Section 54 of the Act.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners. Prima facie, the reasons assigned by the learned Single Judge for refusing to condone aforesaid delay are legally unsustainable.

Issue notice to the respondents to show why leave may not be granted, the impugned order may not be set aside with a direction to the High Court to decide the appeals filed by the petitioners under Section 54 of the Act on merits.
