We have perused the record and heard the learned counsel for the Appellants.

The National Consumers Disputes Redressal Commission has refused to interfere

in revision in respect of an order of the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission

upholding in Appeal the order of the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum

awarding a paltry sum of Rs.1500/- as compensation and Rs.500/- as costs.

We do not think that there is any important question of law, which needs to be

decided in this matter.

Considering the amount that has been awarded, we do not think that it is a fit

case for interference under Article 136 of the Constitution. Leaving open the question of

law, assuming if there is any, we dismiss this Appeal.
