**OFFICE REPORT**

It is submitted to the Hon'ble Court that the Petitioner Land Acquisition officer has impugned the order of the High Court upholding the order of the Reference Court enhancing the market value of the land at Rs. 20/- per square yard.

The matters above-mentioned were listed before the Hon'ble Court on 4<sup>th</sup> March, 2011, when the Court was pleased to pass the following Order:-

“Issue notice on the applications seeking condonation of delay as well as on the Special Leave Petitions.”

Subsequently, the matters above-mentioned were listed before the Registrar Court on 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2015, when he was pleased to pass the following Order:-

The office report indicates that the service report from the Trial Court has not been received as yet. A reminder shall be issued.

SLP(C) No. 6978/2011

The matter has already been directed to be listed before the Hon'ble Judge in Chamber. Therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in it.

SLP(C) No. 6982/2011

Fresh steps for the service of notice by usual mode to the unserved respondent No. 5 shall be taken by the learned counsel for the petitioner within a period of three weeks. Dasti in addition is permitted to be served through the Trial Court the particulars of which shall be furnished by the learned counsel for the petitioner within the period prescribed above.

The office report indicates that service of notice is complete on the other respondents but no one has entered appearance on their behalf.

**SLP(C) Nos. 6971/2011, 6973/2011, 6974/2011, 6976/2011, 6979/2011, 6980/2011, 6981/2011**

It is submitted to the Hon'ble Court that Mr. V.R. Anumolu, counsel for the petitioners has on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 filed address of concerned District Court and fresh show cause notice to the sole Respondent in each matter above-mentioned through concerned Trial Court was issued on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2014, but no affidavit of service alongwith proof thereof has been received so far. A reminder to the Trial court was also issued on 27<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 but no service report has been received so far.

Service is not complete.

**SLP(C) No. 6978 of 2011**

It is submitted to the Hon'ble Court that there are four Respondents in the matter. Mr. C.S.N. Mohan Rao, Advocate has filed vakalatnama/appearance on behalf of Respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 4.

Service is not complete on Respondent No. 2.

**SLP (C) NOS.6982 of 2011**

It is submitted to the Hon'ble Court that Mr. V.R. Anumolu, counsel for the petitioners has on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2015 filed requisite spare copy and address of concerned District Court and fresh show cause notice to unserved Respondent No. 5 was issued on 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2015. Neither AD cards nor unserved cover has been received back so far.

It is further submitted that notice through Trial Court was also issued but no service report thereof has been received so far.

There are total 11 respondents in the matter. Signed AD Cards have been received from respondent Nos.1 to 4 and 6 to 11. Service is not complete on respondent no.5.

The matters above-mentioned are listed before the Hon'ble Court with this office report.
