O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 30.10.2025 in FA0(OS) 79/2023 titled "*Tikka Brijinder Singh Bedi vs. Neelmani Singh and Others*" passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi.
3. Issue notice, returnable on 11.05.2026.
4. Mr. Prateek K. Chadha, Advocate-on-Record, who appears on caveat, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1. Hence, the formal service of notice upon the respondent no.1 is waived. In the meantime, let the appearing party may file counter affidavit, if not already filed, within two weeks.
5. Let notice be issued to the remaining respondents.
6. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within two weeks.
7. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondents are required to file their counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
8. Till the next date of hearing, all proceedings in CS(OS) No.207 of 2021 pending before the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi shall remain stayed.
