to interfere with the order granting bail. However, the petitioner has apprehension

about her safety in view of the alleged threats that are being given by the accused to

her. It is also stated that a representation in this regard was made by the petitioner to

the District Magistrate more than once. Suffice it to observe that in case the petitioner

or her sister encounters any threats or other offensive acts of the accused imperiling

is their safety, they may approach the learned Sessions Judge (before whom the trial

pending) and the Superintendent of Police, who will look into the said complaint and

take appropriate steps. With these observations, the special leave petitions are

dismissed.
