UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioners are aggrieved by the judgment dated 22.12.2025 passed by the High Court of Calcutta (Circuit Bench at Port Blair),

whereby their revision petitions seeking quashing of FIR No.35/2025 dated 13.07.2025, registered at Cyber Crime Police Station of South Andaman District, has been dismissed.

2. We have heard Mr. Sidharth Luthra, learned senior counsel, representing the petitioners and perused the record.

3. It is fairly admitted that after the investigation, charge-sheet has been filed. That being so, we are not inclined to entertain these petitions. The petitioners, if so advised, may move an application for their discharge. Such an application shall be considered by the Trial Magistrate in accordance with law.

4. With a view to enable the petitioners to join the Court proceedings, it is directed that the arrest of the petitioners, namely, Latifa Bano in SLP(Crl.) No.1793/2026 and Vaibhav Gupta in SLP(Crl.) No.1790/2026 shall remain stayed, subject to their surrendering before the Trial Court within two weeks and furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court. The learned Magistrate shall be at liberty to impose such other conditions as may be deemed appropriate.

5. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, disposed of.

6. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
