O R D E R

1. Exemption Application is allowed.
2. The petitioner has been denied anticipatory bail by the High Court in connection with First Information Report bearing No.260 of 2025 registered with Keshpur Police Station, Sub-Division Sadar, District MDP (W) for the offence punishable under Sections 329(4), 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 303(2) and 3(5) respectively of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023 (for short "the BNS 2023").

3. While issuing notice, we had ordered that no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

4. We heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for the State of W.B.

5. In the facts and circumstances of this case, and more particularly, when all other co-accused have been released on bail, we are of the view that the petitioner deserves to be granted the benefit of anticipatory bail.

6. In the result, we order that in the event of arrest of the petitioner in connection with the offence, enumerated above, he shall be released on bail, subject to terms and conditions that the Investigating Officer may deem fit to impose.

7. Once the petitioner is released on bail by the IO, he shall thereafter appear before the Trial Court and furnish fresh bail bonds.

8. With the aforesaid, this petition stands disposed of.

9. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
