O R D E R

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that although the sentence imposed on the petitioner was two months of imprisonment for an offence under the Negotiable Instruments Act, the order was directed to be kept in abeyance with liberty to the petitioner to pay the compensation within a period of three months. It is now informed that the amount has already been paid to the complainant-respondent and it is no longer necessary for the petitioner to press this special

leave petition. Consequently, the application seeking exemption from surrender is also not required to be pressed. Under the circumstance, the special leave petition itself has been rendered infructuous. Learned counsel therefore sought permission to withdraw the special leave petition which is permitted and the application seeking exemption from surrender be treated as infructuous.
