O R D E R

This appeal by the State of Uttar Pradesh is directed against the judgment of the Allahabad High Court by which the High Court, reversing the judgment of the trial court, acquitted all the ten accused (respondents before this Court) of the charge under Section 302 read with Section 149 of the Penal Code. It is a case of triple murder. The appeal before this Court was filed in the year 2003 and yet a prayer is made for adjournment for submitting translated copies of the deposition of witnesses.
