

the petition. We have also seen the office report in which it is indicated that the respondent has been duly served. In spite of service, the respondent has not appeared in Court nor any counter affidavit has been filed controverting the averments made in the petition.

In that view of the matter, we have no option but to accept the averments in the petition. Consequently, the transfer petition is allowed. Divorce Petition M.C. No.4625 of 2012, as indicated above, is transferred to the Family Court Ernakulam, Kerala State.
