O R D E R

Permission to file SLP granted in SLP(C).....(CC. 7213-7214/2003).

Leave granted.

Printing dispensed with. The appeals shall be heard on the SLP paperbooks. Parties may complete the pleadings and file additional documents, if any, within four weeks. Original record shall be requisitioned.

There are heavy financial stakes involved and it is submitted that any delay in hearing may be ruinous to the parties.
