O R D E R

This is wife's petition seeking transfer of Matrimonial Case No. 1823/2011 titled "C. Ravi Kiran Vs. Geetha Mutyaboina @ Chitteti Geetha" filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending in the Court of IVth Additional Judge, Family Court, Bangalore to the Family Court or to the court of competent jurisdiction at Vijayawada, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh.

2. Notice of the transfer petition has been served on the respondent and he has filed counter affidavit in opposition to the transfer petition.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

4. Having regard to the fact that the petitioner-wife resides at Vijayawada, we are satisfied that greater hardship shall be caused to her in case the proceedings are allowed to be continued in the above matrimonial case at Bangalore.

5. We, accordingly, allow the transfer petition and transfer Matrimonial Case No. 1823/2011 titled "C. Ravi Kiran Vs. Geetha Mutyaboina @ Chitteti Geetha" from the Court of IVth Additional Judge, Family Court, Bangalore to the Principal District Judge, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh. It will be open to the Principal District Judge, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh to transfer the above matrimonial case for disposal to any other competent court within his jurisdiction. The transferor court shall transmit the record and proceedings of the above transferred case to the transferee court without any delay. No costs.
