O R D E R

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned senior counsel for the caveator, we dispose of this Special Leave Petition by reserving liberty to the petitioners herein to seek reasonable interest on the amount to be awarded to the petitioners herein as per their respective shares before the jurisdictional Executing Court.

It is needless to observe that this right to seek reasonable interest is in addition to the decree passed by the Trial Court and which has been affirmed by the High Court.

The parties are also at liberty to arrive at a mediated settlement with regard to the reasonable rate of interest that the petitioners are entitled to and the duration for which the interest is to be paid.
