UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. I.A. No.39265/2026 i.e., permission to file Special Leave Petition is granted.

2. The petitioner, original first informant (son of the deceased) being dissatisfied with the grant of regular bail to the respondent no.2 (original accused) in connection with FIR No.48/2024 registered with Dantaramgarh Police Station, District Sikar, State of Rajasthan for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 302, 307 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short, "the IPC"), respectively, is here before us with the present petition.

3. Heard Ms. Pushkara A. Bhonsle, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Puneet Parihar, the learned counsel appearing for the State of Rajasthan.

4. We take notice of the fact that the trial is already in progress. The prosecution has already examined 20 witnesses. The trial is practically at the fag end.

5. In such circumstances, we are of the view that we should not disturb the order passed by the High Court, releasing the respondent no.2 on bail.

6. It is needless to clarify that the guilt or the innocence of the accused persons shall be decided on the basis of the oral evidence that may come on record.

7. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stand disposed of.

8. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
