O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 06.11.2025 in A482 No. 37918/2013 titled "*Sajid Ali alias Guddu vs. State of U.P. & Anr.*" passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner invites our attention to the plaint filed in the year 2012 (Page 18) and the order granting permanent injunction dated 19.05.2012 passed by the Trial Court (page 42). The subject matter in the allegations are same and similar. The complaint in question was filed on 20.04.2012 with the institution of civil proceedings *inter se* the parties.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 24.04.2026.
4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within two weeks.
5. In the notice itself let it be mentioned that respondents are required to file their counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.
