O R D E R

1. Petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 12.11.2025 in Criminal Revision No.851/2024 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, titled "*Puneet Angra vs. State of U.P. & Ors.*".
2. Issue notice only for the purpose of exploring the possibility of settlement.
3. Mr. Amit Pai, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf

of all the respondents. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondents is waived.

4. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.

5. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center on 06.04.2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.

6. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.

7. If the learned Mediator requires the physical presence of the respondent no.1/wife, then the travel, lodging and boarding expenses of her shall be borne by the petitioner/husband.

8. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 21.05.2026.
