O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. The petitioner is in custody in connection with an offence under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 wherein around 1200 bottles of Phensedyl Syrup containing Triprolidine Hydro Chloride Codeine Phosphate were allegedly recovered from a car in which he was travelling. The charge sheet has already been filed and there appears to be no need for

custodial interrogation.

3. Therefore, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, we consider it proper to enlarge the petitioner on bail, more particularly when one another co-accused has already been granted bail, subject to such terms and conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court Commensurating with the allegations/charges against him.

4. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of with the direction to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
