Leave granted.

The appellant seeks bail in connection with FIR CR No.11191011240248/2024 dated 27.09.2024, registered with Police Station DCB, Ahmedabad City, District Ahmedabad City, for the offences punishable under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 336(3), 337, 338, 340(2), 61,204,3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

From the counter affidavit filed and upon hearing the arguments, it is not in dispute that all the co-accused persons have been released on bail. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submitted that the appellant has been in custody for more than 1 year and 4 months. Further, the charges are yet to be framed and, therefore, the trial would take considerable time to conclude, as it is submitted that 49 witnesses yet are to be examined. Considering the above, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and the appellant is granted bail on terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

The appeal stands allowed, accordingly.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

From the counter affidavit filed and upon hearing the arguments, it is not in dispute that all the co-accused persons have been released on bail. Learned counsel appearing for the appellant submitted that the appellant has been in custody for more than one year and 4 months. Though the trial commenced, only 1 of the witnesses has been examined.

Taking into consideration the period of incarceration and the likelihood of the trial

being delayed, we are inclined to grant bail to the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and the appellant is granted bail on terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

The appeal stands allowed, accordingly.
