Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, as well as the respondent, we are satisfied that no

intervention is called for in the special leave petitions, which are, accordingly, dismissed.

However, the petitioner will be entitled to occupy the suit premises till 30th September, 2012, upon deposit of a consolidated sum of Rs.15,000/-, both for the arrears, as well as the current rents. Such amount is to be deposited within a month from date. In the event the said amount is not deposited, this order will cease to have effect and the respondent decree holder will be entitled to execute the decree and take possession of the suit premises. This order is also subject to an undertaking being given by the petitioner in the above terms, also within the said period.
