



After giving several opportunities,

on 21.08.2009

finally four weeks time was granted to enable the petitioner to file an application for substituted service to serve the unserved respondents. The application has not been filed and the learned counsel for the petitioner again seeks time. No justifiable cause or reason is assigned for asking for time. Hence, four weeks time is granted to the petitioner to do so subject to the petitioner depositing Rs.5,000/- as costs with the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee and producing acknowledgment within four weeks. If the petitioner fails to take steps to serve the unserved respondents or pay costs, the transfer petitions against those respondents shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution without further notice.
